This new program will have some restrictions:

1) GDMC disks will ONLY be available at the membership meetings. No GDMC disks will be mailed...

2) GDMC disks are available to 'Club Members Only'.

3) New members or existing members that sign-up after the start of this program can receive GDMC on a pro-rated basis.

4) Single back issues disks will be available in limited quantities for \$1.50 each.

5) GDMC is a non-refundable program.

6) There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to the above.

Finally, Glenside has collected a full gambit of PD software and is making it available to it's members. If you have any questions regarding GDMC, please bring them to the August meeting.

To close out this months article, I'll ask you one quick question, "How do you like the NEW newsletter format?".

It has been quite some time since we last did a ONE TANDY CENTER article, so the editorial pen might be a little dull. What I would like to discuss is the close out of the CoCo 2 equipment. A few months ago, word came down that Tandy has stopped all production of this computer. Along with this announcement, word of the Multi-Pak, the 501 Drive0 system, the RS-232 Pak and a host of CoCo 2 software was being dropped as well. Overall this news did not send that big of a shock wave to the CoCo Community. The only units that had a few people concerned was that of the Multi-Pak and the RS-232 Pak being dropped. With the advent of OS-9 Level 2, both units almost have to be considered standard equipment. But the loss of the CoCo 2 and it's companion software was of little surprise. The CoCo 1 & 2 served out their purpose and had to give way to it's offspring, the CoCo 3. Like all hybrids, this is a natural course of events. I for one have very strong sentimental feelings towards my 'old gray case' CoCo 1. It not only served me well, but it stood the test of time and competition.

When Tandy released the CoCo 3, I knew that it would only be a matter of time before retirement set in for the 1 & 2. However, the legacy that these two systems created is one to be admired. Name any other affordable personal computer that not only lived three lives but continued to thrive in popularity. I'm at a loss to think of one. Lets take it one step further and say, name another affordable personal computer that lived three lives and maintained almost full compatibility with each other...don't snap a brain cell trying to thing of such a system...it just does not exist!
